As you plan your migration to O365, there are many options within the Administrator Security and Compliance Console. Some companies circle back to the settings and policies after migration, which makes it more difficult to ensure adoption by end users. An Osterman research survey report published in May 2017, found that 23% of respondents inadvertently exposed data, and 11% did not meet compliance obligations during and after their O365 migration.

They are going to put it out there...

A recent survey found that 17.4% of documents in OneDrive and SharePoint contain sensitive data. Personally identifiable info, health info, payment data, company confidential data should be protected. A subset of documents contain the word "password" in the file name. A recent audit found over 6000 documents with the word "salary" in the filename.

They are going to share it with someone...

18% of shared files are shared with a personal email address (Gmail, Hotmail, Yahoo). If O365 is not configured correctly the share can be forwarded on to unintended recipients. It is estimated that 29% of data shared is at high risk if shared to the wrong person.
